



AUTHORISATION FOR REGULAR TRANSPORTATION Peak Sports & Learning Albion Park (Tullimbar)

Reason for transport:

To deliver children to and/or collect children from their enrolled school for the purpose of attending Before School Care (BSC) and/or After School Care (ASC) at Peak Sports & Learning Albion Park (Tullimbar).

When transports occurs:

Monday to Fridays, during NSW school term.

Description of proposed pick up locations and destinations:

Peak Sports & Learning Albion Park (the service): Tullimbar Public School, 1 Exeter Place Tullimbar NSW 2527

Albion Park Rail Public School: Tongarra Rd, Albion Park Rail NSW 2527. Bus parking on Tongarra Rd at the front of the bus bay.

Albion Park Public School: Corner of Hamilton Rd &, Tongarra Rd, Albion Park NSW 2527. Bus parking on Taylor Rd in the bus bay where available.

Calderwood Christian School: 234 Calderwood Rd, Calderwood NSW 2527. Bus parking inside school in the bus bay.

St Paul's Catholic Primary School: 247-251 Tongarra Rd, Albion Park NSW 2527. Bus parking on Tongarra Rd at the front of the bus bay.

The means of transport:

The children will be transported by privately owned buses operated by an appropriately licensed and trained Peak Sports and Learning driver.

Period of time during which transport occurs:

Before School Care: 8:20am – 9:00am

After School Care: 3:00pm – 3:40pm

Transportation is dependent on school starting and finishing times. These times are approximate and are estimated based on the event that there are children from all schools serviced for pick up / drop off. Daily attendance rolls determine which schools require pick up and drop off. Times may change in the event of road closures, inclement weather, traffic incident/conditions or in the event that an ASC attendance or absence requires follow up.

Anticipated number of children likely to be transported:

The maximum number of children on a bus is 23. The number of children on the bus will vary depending on each day's attendance roll. On average there is approximately 15 children for ASC and 11 children for BSC on the bus.

Anticipated number of staff:

The anticipated number of staff is based on the needs of the bus run and service requirements. Adequate supervision will be determined by the Responsible person of the service and will take into account the duration of the bus run, ages of children, children with additional needs and other factors (see transport safety management plan for more information). It is anticipated that there will be a minimum of 2 staff members accompanying the children during transit.

Requirements for seatbelts or safety restraints:

All buses are fitted with seatbelts therefore all children are required to wear their seatbelt at all times during transit.
